

Documents Required When Having an Upgraded Qualification/Degree

Qualifications such as for example, Higher National Diploma (HND) and Higher National Certificate (HNC) are usually one- or two-year degrees and, as such, not alone sufficient to provide eligibility to Master's Degree Programmes, where a degree equivalent to a three-year Bachelor's Degree is the requirement.

If you have upgraded for example, your HND/HNC to a Bachelor's Degree, you may be eligible to Master's Degree Programmes.

In such case, you need to submit your Degree Certificate and Transcript of Records for both your HND/HNC and your Bachelor's Degree in order to show your eligibility.

If the HND/HNC and Bachelor's Degree were completed in different countries, different country-specific requirements have to be taken into account regarding to document authentication.

If your degree contains studies completed at another institution and the transferred credits are not indicated in detail on your Transcript of Records, a separate Transcript of Records regarding the transferred credits has to be submitted.

Please also note any relevant country-specific requirements regarding to document authentication.

The rule applies to all upgraded Qualifications/Degrees.
