First-year students in LUT's English-language Master's Programme in Water Technology are now seeking internships. Their skills are ideal for companies in the process and water industries.

Our students can:

- » Work in water treatment plants and other operational roles
- » Assist in research and planning tasks
- » Perform sample preparation and water-related analyses after orientation. The students have basic knowledge of TOC, IC, ICP, and UV/VIS analyses

Internships offer companies a low-risk way to connect with future professionals in a field facing a shortage of skilled workers. It's also a great opportunity to introduce students to your operations and bring fresh perspectives into your organisation.

Internships last a minimum of four weeks. Afterward, students can continue with your company in a summer job, part-time role, or even through a master's thesis project.*
